**Hoff-Barthelson Music School's Festival Orchestra** is a full symphonic orchestra for high school students at the highest level of technical ability and musical artistry. Members participate in the **NEW YORK PHILHARMONIC ACADEMY JR. PROGRAM**, which includes attending a rehearsal and post-rehearsal discussion at Lincoln Center and an evening of sectional coaching at the School by members of the Philharmonic.



## Performances:

Under the direction of **CONDUCTOR JUN NAKABAYASHI**, the Festival Orchestra performs four concerts annually; two are with guest artists of international stature in full-length concerto performances. The final concert of the season is held at the Performing Arts Center at Purchase College.

## Audition Requirements:

Applicants must perform a 2 minute section from a piece written for their instrument that is comparable to a NYSSMA Level 6 piece; scales; and prepared excerpts. Timpani and percussion applicants must perform a demonstration of rolls; a rudimentary solo of choice; and prepared excerpts. *(See excerpts information on page 2.)*

## 2017-18 Festival Orchestra Audition Requirements

Auditions are scheduled to last 7 minutes and include scales chosen by the conductor; two minutes of a section of your prepared piece (equivalent to NYSSMA level 6 or above) that demonstrates your best technique and musicality; and prepared sections of the Beethoven Symphony No. 3. Refer to the chart below for specific scale and excerpt requirements by instrument.

<a href="#">Viola</a>	One or two major scales chosen by the conductor from all 15 major scales in 2 octaves by memory.	1st movement, b.118 to 1st ending	2nd movement, Letter A to b.47
<a href="#">Cello</a>	One or two major scales chosen by the conductor and played from memory from all 15 major scales in 3 octaves.	1st movement, Letter F to G	2nd movement, Letter A to b.47
<a href="#">Bass</a>	One or two major scales chosen by the conductor and played from memory from the 2 octave scales e, f, f sharp, g only, and the rest of the 11 major scales in 1 octave only.	1st movement, Letter F to G	2nd movement, Letter A to b.47
