Education has been a major component of Chauncey Patterson's career. His faculty affiliations include The Cleveland Institute of Music, Blossom School of Music, Hartt School of Music, Encore School for Strings, Eastern Music Festival, and New World School of the Arts. During his tenure as violist, the Miami String Quartet won the Concert Artist Guild New York Competition. He serves as Solo Viola of the Florida Grand Opera.

Master class coaching by guest artists has been part of Hoff-Barthelson's curriculum since the School's founding in 1944. Master classes are an enlightening experience for students and audiences alike. After months of careful preparation, students perform for, and then receive feedback and guidance from a master teacher who challenges the student to think in new and critical ways about the piece they've prepared. The results are inspiring and serve as a catalyst for students to reach new heights in their own musical explorations.
