

SUZUKI PRE-TWINKLERS



Preschoolers are introduced to violin studies and the joy of making music in a group experience while learning to play the instrument. Rhythm and pitch patterns drawn from the first Suzuki songs are introduced through the music and movement component of this class.

One 40 minute class, weekday afternoons

Pre-Twinklers progress to the full HBMS Suzuki Program.

THE SUZUKI METHOD

Shinichi Suzuki pioneered the idea that any preschool age child could begin to play the violin if learning steps were small enough and the instrument was scaled down to fit the body. His method, which he called "Talent Education," was modeled after his theories of natural language acquisition. Suzuki believed that every child, if properly taught, was capable of a high level of musical achievement. The Suzuki Method combines listening, proper technique, repetition and reinforcement with active parental involvement.
