Private Instruction

Private lesson instruction of the highest caliber is offered at Hoff-Barthelson. Instruction is offered on more than 20 instruments, voice, and composition over 16-week fall and spring semesters and a flexible summer term.

Our flexible **Private Lesson Program** allows you to select enrollment options that best match your goals and nurture your potential within the time you have available to dedicate to your musical experience. Options include *Private Lesson + 1 Class or Ensemble*, *Private Lesson + 2 Classes or Ensembles*, *Private Lesson + 3 or More Classes or Ensembles* and *Private Lesson only*. *Partner Lessons* (lessons shared with a friend) are also available. In addition to private instruction, *Private Lesson Program* students enjoy ensemble opportunities; access to musicianship classes; group classes; professional accompaniment for strings, winds, brass, and voice; performance workshops and recital opportunities; and progress reports.

Ensemble Opportunities

Adult Chamber Music

Adults playing at intermediate and advanced levels make music together in a duo, trio, quartet, or larger chamber ensemble. Ensembles rehearse for 20 weeks, October through May, and enjoy multiple performance opportunities. Chamber groups are formed based on student playing levels by a faculty coordinator. Students are welcome to suggest ensemble partners or, if they already perform in an ensemble, to register as a pre-formed group.

20 sessions per year. Coaching sessions for trios and larger ensembles are 60-minutes in duration. Coaching sessions for duos are 45-minutes in duration. Day and time are custom scheduled for each ensemble. Trios and larger, \$1105; Duos \$1635.

Adult Flute Choir

Hoff-Barthelson welcomes flutists to one of three flute ensembles: the Adult Flute Choir, age 18 and up; the Flute Club for flutists who are grade 8-12 and are performing at a NYSSMA Level 5-6; and the Junior Flutes for flutists who are grades 1-7. The groups perform at each of the School's major festivals. They combine for performances at the annual Flute Plus! event which celebrates all-things flute with performances, premieres of commissioned works, and clinics with invited flute luminaries.

Adult Theory 1 ‡

This class is suitable for adult students with no or minimal music theory training. Instruction focuses on the core elements of music theory including key signatures, pitch and notation, rhythm and meter, intervals, scales, chords, melody and composition, analysis, and music history/appreciation. Classes utilize a variety of printed and digital instructional resources to support student learning and progress. Class time includes guided listening and discussion of music through the ages.

Adult Theory 2 ‡

This class is designed for adult music students – instrumentalists, vocalists, and composers - who seek to develop a durable foundation in music theory and aural training fundamentals. A comprehensive overview of foundational concepts in written music is paired with aural training and listening assignments designed to develop familiarity with how music theory sounds and how it appears in actual repertoire. Some exposure to basic elements of music will be helpful but is not required. Students wishing to continue their study of the piano following completion of this class are invited to register for private piano lessons at the School.
