**irst Instruments Mini-Sessions** are specially designed small group classes for students entering grades 4-5 who are just starting — or who plan to start — an instrument as part of their school's band or orchestra program. Taught by members of **Hoff-Barthelson's renowned faculty**, mini-sessions provide students with a foundation in instrumental technique, music reading, and ensemble playing.

**CLASS DETAILS:** Each mini-session includes four one-hour-long class meetings. Classes are organized by instrument; students must provide their own instrument; Hoff-Barthelson provides all instructional materials.

**CLASS SIZE:** minimum enrollment: 4 — maximum enrollment: 8.

**TUITION:** \$150 per person (including materials and registration fee).

**REGISTRATION:** Mini-sessions may begin whenever a group of four or more students interested in learning the same instrument can be scheduled into an available time slot with an HBMS faculty member.

**INSTRUCTION AVAILABLE FOR:** violin, viola, cello, flute, oboe, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone and percussion.
