Hoff-Barthelson Music School's 2026 **Music of Our Time Festival** celebrates the vitality of contemporary music through performances, collaborations, and the creation of new works. A centerpiece of the Festival is the **world premiere of *We long to wake* by composer Flannery Cunningham**, commissioned through the Wilma Machover Fund, alongside the second annual **Micro-Commissions Project**, a unique partnership with the Manhattan School of Music that pairs HBMS students with emerging composers to create original works tailored to each performer.

The Festival also highlights **composer-performer collaborations**, with students working directly with living composers to prepare and present their music, gaining insight that brings these works vividly to life.

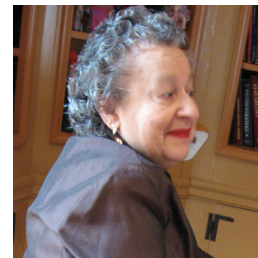
